Make up a multiple choice quiz for others to test their knowledge.	Research the Egyptian's mathematics system. How does it compare to ours today? Are there any benefits? Maybe a dance to impress/entertain a pharaoh? Or a dance to show the tiring life of a slave?	Follow a recipe from Egypt. It could be something simple. Share it with your family. Ask them to rate the food.	Question for debate: Should people be allowed to excavate the ancient tombs?	Create a play with a Tutankhamun theme. Perform your play to others.
