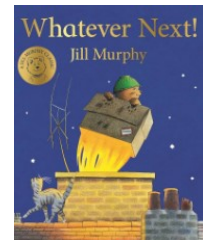

Communication and Language

Talk with your family members (and listen to them too!) - what do you love about winter?

Physical Development

Place some flour on a tray / table top and pretend it's snow! What patterns can you create? Can you write some words too?

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Talk about astronauts and what they do. Would you like to be an astronaut? What would you pack for your space adventure?

Literacy

Build a reading rocket! Use big boxes / furniture to create a reading rocket. Then snuggle in your rocket with your favourite books and go on an adventure!

Understanding the World

Go on a local walk / adventure. What do you see, hear, and feel?

Expressive Arts and Design

Create your own picture of a bear using craft materials.

Mathematics

Make a collection of winter natural objects—twigs, holly, pine cones etc.
