

Years 4 Homework Grid Up, Up and Away

This grid shows the homework that is connected to the topic for the whole term. There may also be additional maths and/ or spelling, as well as an expectation that the children read regularly at home.

For the topic related homework, it is expected that the children complete one activity each fortnight.

Each activity must be from a different row and from a different column.

For example, in the first fortnight they may choose to do the 'Paris art activity'; the next fortnight they may wish to do the 'Holidays maths activity'; the third fortnight it may be 'Brighton ICT activity' etc.

Maps 	Make a bird's eye view of your bedroom. How can you show what is in your bedroom and where in your bedroom you would find it?	Co-ordinates Make a map of an imaginary place. It could be a town, a park or a desert island. Make sure you draw it on a labelled grid and write down the co-ordinates of where you would find different places.	Imagine you are flying high above the land in a hot air balloon. Paint an aerial picture of the land that you fly over.	Find or make a map - use it to give people directions to get from one place to another. Try and use the 8 compass directions to help you move around (N, S, E, W, NE, NW, SE, SW)) (Make a movie or take photos of someone using your map.)	Can you write a set of simple instructions to use google earth?	Explore the world using Google Earth or try exploring a town or city by using Google maps
Holidays 	Where have you been on holiday? Was there some special food that was linked to that place? Pizza from Italy, pasty from Cornwall, paella from Spain? Could you try and make this food at home?	Pretend you are going to plan a really exciting holiday. Go to a travel agent and get some holiday brochures for somewhere that you would like to visit. How much will it cost to take a family of four? When would you want to go? Do prices change throughout the year? When is the cheapest time to go? When is the most expensive?	Design a postcard for a place that you have visited.	Give an oral presentation about a holiday that you have enjoyed. Make it really interesting, show some photographs if you have any.	Write a postcard home from a place that you have visited. Don't forget to include what you have done there, the weather and what you still might be planning to do.	Photograph and annotate a journey that you have made. It might be a special journey or holiday or it might be a simple journey that you make every day, such as your journey to school.

Brighton 	Make a 3D model of a Brighton attraction. It could be the Pavilion, the Pier, or even the new i360.	Find a local bus timetable. How long will it take you to go by bus from Portslade to Churchill square? If you wanted to leave Portslade at about 9am, what time would you get to Brighton? What time would you have to leave if you wanted to be in Brighton for 9am?	Make a collage of Brighton attractions.	Pretend that you are giving people a guided tour of Brighton. What interesting information would you be able to tell them about Brighton?	Make an information leaflet about Brighton Tourist attractions. Don't forget to include places to visit, where you can eat and where you could stay.	Take photographs around Brighton; turn these in to a simple animation/ film using windows movie maker, imovie, photo story or something similar.
Paris 	Make a 3D model of a Paris attraction. It could be the Eiffel Tower, the Arc de Triomphe or the Pyramide du Louvre.	Look at the menu below. What food, pudding and drink would you order? How much would it cost you? What would be the cheapest three things to order? What about the most expensive? What could you order for about €7.00?	Make a collage of Paris attractions.	Look at a French phrase book. Pick out 3 useful phrases to teach to the class.	Write your own story that is set in Paris - how do we know it is in Paris?	Research 3 tourists attractions in Paris. Create a tourist blog telling people why they should visit them.
UK 	Make a jigsaw of the countries or counties of the UK.	Choose 5 or more cities in Britain. Find how far away these cities are from Brighton. Could you show this on a table chart or graph? How far I sit between the different cities? If you went from Brighton to one city and then on to another, how far would you have travelled?	What can you see from your window? Draw or paint your view?	Tell us about somewhere you have enjoyed visiting in the UK. Come and tell us what you have found out.

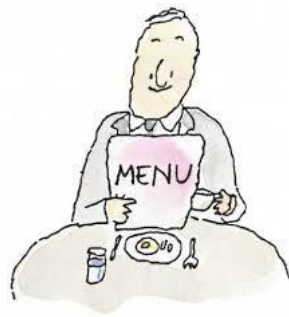
