Search for images of New York's skyline to show what people travelling to America on a ship might see.



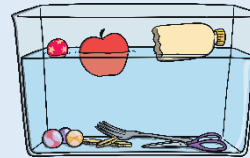
Maths

- How many funnels did the Titanic have?

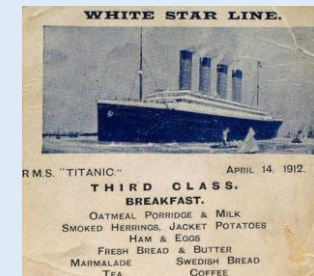
Science
