Design Technology

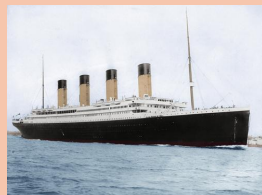

We will also focus on learning new spelling patterns this term and ensuring we use what we have learnt in Phonics sessions in our writing.
